Kiranis is a series 30 years in the making, and will have 7 books. They are all meticulously planned and Book 4 releases in August '26. 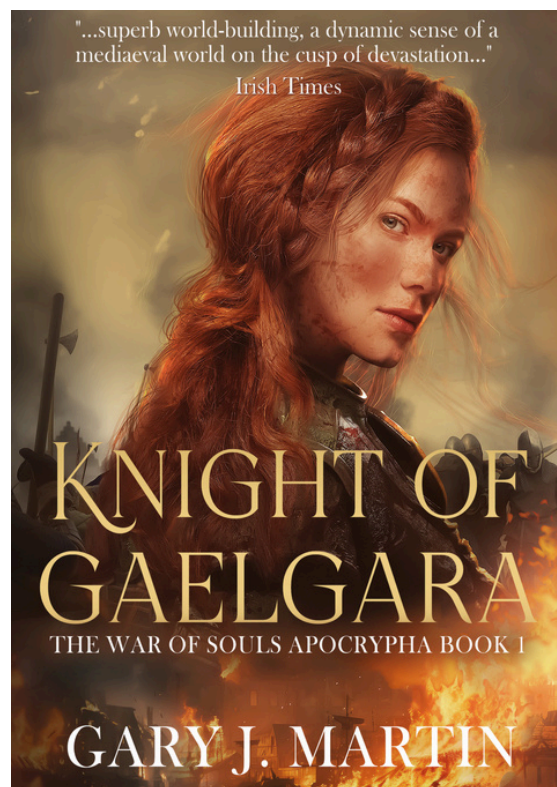


HEAR YE ALL!

A TIME FOR WAR

American author of Military Sci-Fi Tyler E. C. Burnworth (AKA Pacey Holden) delivers a blistering action adventure among the stars in **Redshift**, the opener to his trilogy **By Blood Or By Star**. Having worked on Nellis Air Force base while he was writing this book, Tyler knows his stuff, and we can feel it in the developing camaraderie of the troops, their naiveté as they're plunged into a war they don't understand, and every trigger pulled and bullet fired. We highly recommend checking out the trailers on the title pages.



A **Apogee** expands Abraham's universe, plunging us headlong into a conspiracy to change everything. This time a parallel story featuring a female detective delivers a sort of cyperpunk feel to the novel, as she delves into shady dealings with augmented humans and moves ever closer to the same people manipulating Abraham. Abraham has more than come of age at this point, but he's still as malleable to people who know how to use human weapons to their own ends.
